**October 2**

FCQ. 109 – *How many things do we pray for in the Lord’s Prayer?* Six.

FCQ. 110 – *What do we pray first?* “Hallowed be your name.”

FCQ. 111 – *What does it mean to pray, “Hollowed be your name”?* We are asking God to enable us and all creation to honor his name.

SCQ. 96 – *What is the Lord’s Supper?* The Lord’s Supper is a sacrament, wherein, by giving and receiving bread and wine, according to Christ’s appointment, his death is showed forth; and the worthy receivers are, not after a corporal and carnal manner, but by faith, made partakers of his body and blood, with all his benefits, to their spiritual nourishment, and growth in grace.

SCQ 97. – *What is required for the worthy receiving of the Lord’s Supper?* It is required of them that would worthily partake of the Lord’s Supper, that they examine themselves of their knowledge to discern the Lord’s body, of their faith to feed upon him, of their repentance, love, and new obedience; lest, coming unworthily, they eat and drink judgment to themselves.

**October 9**

FCQ. 112 – *What do we pray second?* “Your kingdom come.”

FCQ. 113 – *What does it mean to pray, “Your kingdom come”?* We are asking God to bring more and more people to believe and obey his gospel.

SCQ. 98 – *What is prayer?* Prayer is an offering up of our desires unto God, for things agreeable to his will, in the name of Christ, with confession of our sins, and thankful acknowledgment of his mercies.

**October 16**

FCQ. 114 – *What do we pray third?* “Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.”

FCQ. 115 – *What does it mean to pray, “Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven”?* We are asking God to make us able and willing to serve him as the angels do in heaven.

SCQ. 99 – *What rule has God given for our direction in prayer?* The whole Word of God is of use to direct us in prayer; but the special rule of direction is that form of prayer which Christ taught his disciples, commonly called the Lord’s Prayer.

**October 23**

FCQ. 116 – *What do we pray fourth?* “Give us today our daily bread.”

FCQ. 117 – *What does it mean to pray, “Give us this day our daily bread”?* We are asking God to provide us with all that we really need.

SCQ. 100 – *What does the preface of the Lord’s Prayer teach us?* The preface of the Lord’s Prayer, which is, Our Father in heaven, teaches us to draw near to God with all holy reverence and confidence, as children to a father, able and ready to help us; and that we should pray with and for others.

## **November 6**

FCQ. 118 – *What do we pray fifth?* “Forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors.”

FCQ. 119 – *What does it mean to pray, “Forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors”?* We are asking God to forgive our sins for Christ’s sake, and to make us willing to forgive others.

SCQ. 101 – *What do we pray for in the first petition?* In the first petition, which is, *Hallowed be Your name*, we pray that God would enable us, and others, to glorify him in all that whereby he makes himself known; and that he would dispose all things to his own glory.

## **November 13**

FCQ. 120 – *What do we pray sixth?* “And lead us not in to temptation, but deliver us from the evil one.”

FCQ. 121 – *What does it mean to pray, “And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one?”* We are asking God to keep us from being tempted, or to make us strong enough to resist if we are tempted.

SCQ. 102 – *What do we pray for in the second petition?* In the second petition, which is, *Your kingdom come*, we pray that Satan’s kingdom may be destroyed; and that the kingdom of grace may be advanced, ourselves and others brought into it, and kept in it; and that the kingdom of glory may be hastened.

## **November 20**

Colossians 2:6-7 – As you therefore have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him, rooted and built up in Him and established in the faith, as you have been taught, abounding in it with thanksgiving.

## **November 27**

FCQ. 122 – *How many sacraments are there?* Two.

FCQ. 123 – *What are they called?* Baptism and the Lord’s Supper.

FCQ. 124 – *Who appointed these sacraments?* The Lord Jesus Christ.

SCQ. 103 – *What do we pray for in the third petition?* In the third petition, which is, *Your will be done in earth, as it is in heaven*, we pray that God, by his grace, would make us able and willing to know, obey, and submit to his will in all things, as the angels do in heaven.
